— SANTIAGO DE CHILE

Santiago de Chile is the capital and largest city of Chile, located in the country's Maipo Valley. The city counts with a colonial and European architecture that features a distinctive style that invites thousands of visitors to explore its streets full of museums, stores, and world-class restaurants. Santiago is one the most vibrant and cosmopolitan cities in Latin America, a city that offers you unlimited cultural and leisure activity so you can enjoy the most of it.



— SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA

San Pedro de Atacama is an oasis located in the challenging and quiet Atacama Desert, considered the driest on the planet. It is at 1,198 kilometers from Santiago de Chile, surrounded by mountain ranges, volcanoes with their eternal snow-covered summits, mysterious geo-glyphs, gigantic geysers, impressive salt lakes with their colonies of flamingos, lagoons of intense blue color, and thermal water swimming pools in the middle of magical indigenous towns. San Pedro de Atacama is considered the archaeological capital of Chile and the center of the Atacama culture.



— CUSCO

Cusco is a city in south-eastern Peru, near the Urubamba Valley of the Andes mountain range and its altitude is around 3,400 meters. Formerly, Cusco was capital of the Inca Empire and one of the most important cities in the Viceroyalty of Peru. Nowadays, it is the capital of the Cusco Region as well as the Cusco Province and it was declared a World Heritage Site in 1983 by UNESCO, due to its large number of monuments in the area. Cusco or the “Rome of America” is a major tourist destination and receives almost a million visitors a year, most of them visiting the ancient Inca citadel of Machu Picchu.



— SACRED VALLEY

The Sacred Valley of the Incas or Urubamba Valley is a valley in the Andes of Peru, located at 550 kilometers from Lima, at only 25 kilometers from the Inca capital of Cusco, and below the ancient sacred city of Machu Picchu. The valley is fed by numerous rivers which descend through adjoining valleys and gorges. It contains numerous archaeological remains and indigenous villages. The valley was appreciated by the Incas due to its special geographical and climatic qualities. It was one of the empire's main points for the extraction of natural wealth, and the best place for maize production in Peru.



MACHU PICCHU TOWN / AGUAS CALIENTES

Aguas Calientes is the colloquial name for Machu Picchu Pueblo, a Peruvian town on the shores of Vilcanota River, at 110 kilometers from Cusco and 505 kilometers from Lima. It was founded in 1901 as a camp for the workers building the railway that was supposed to link the cities of Cusco and Santa Ana. Amongst the most important touristic attraction of this place you can find natural hot springs; which are located at only 800 meters from the town and have given the name to this settlement. It is best known as the closest access point to the sacred Incan city of Machu Picchu (in Quechua: old mountain), which is only 6 kilometers away.



— PUERTO MALDONADO

Puerto Maldonado is located in the southeast of the country, is the capital of Madre Dios; it has the official title of Capital of Biodiversity in Peru in recognition of important records of flora and fauna found in the forests of the department, especially in the Manu. The region is home to native tribes for whom the advance of civilization has not yet arrived.



LIMA

Lima is the capital of Peru, inhabited by civilizations that had gauged its wealth and strategic location centuries before it was founded as the City of Kings. Proof of that can be seen in the countless temples that dotted the valley, particularly the Pachacamac shrine, a major pilgrimage center during the Inca empire. This spurred Spanish Conqueror Francisco Pizarro to choose this valley as the capital in 1535 as its location by the sea provided a link with sailing routes. Lima, the main gateway to Peru, is a major city bustling with living history and movement. It is an ethnic melting pot, featuring pre-Hispanic, colonial and modern elements.



DAY 1 - SANTIAGO DE CHILE - SEPTEMBER 26, 2025

DAY 2 - SANTIAGO DE CHILE - SEPTEMBER 27, 2025

Full Day Santiago de Chile Panoramic Sightseeing & San Cristobal Hill

The tour begins with a visit to the historic city center, with the main square as a highlight (Plaza de Armas), kilometer zero and crucial center of the capital, where the construction of Santiago began during the colonial era, with old buildings, such as the Metropolitan Cathedral, a beautiful building that combines Bavarian and neoclassical styles of that time. In this context, a tour through the civic district, with the ministerial building surrounding the government's house, the Palacio de la Moneda, a silent witness of the most relevant event in our republican history. To conclude the historical area, a tour by the old and stately neighborhoods of the old "high society", a place full of an exquisite architectonic variety brought by immigrants, mainly European, in a time of great mining exploitation and high-born families. Later, a magnificent panoramic view from one of our hills in the city, where it is possible to appreciate a part of the mountain-chain slopes that surround the city to, afterward, go to the western area to see the great architectonic contrast. A thriving and contemporary city that proves its best with impressive buildings of daring architectonic styles that represent a seal of modernity to this big city.

DAY 4 - SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA - SEPTEMBER 29, 2025

Half day Chaxa Lagoon & Toconao

Immerse yourself in a surreal landscape as you explore the Salar de Atacama, a vast salt desert that stretches as far as the eye can see. Walk on the bright white salt surface, feeling a sense of tranquility and wonder envelop you. Let yourself be captivated by the iridescent reflections that create a magical illusion on the horizon, as the sun sets and paints the sky in golden and pink tones. Continuing our journey, we will reach the dazzling Chaxa lagoon, a true paradise for wildlife lovers. This is where our winged friends, the pink flamingos, steal the show. After marveling at the beauty of nature, we will head to the charming town of Toconao. Let yourself be seduced by its colonial architecture and cobbled streets, which will transport you to a bygone era. Explore its church of San Lucas, with its volcanic stone bell tower, and admire the craftsmanship of skilled local artisans. Discover the culture and history of this town that has stood the test of time.

Cejar Lagoon & Tebinquinche

We have the privilege of visiting the famous Laguna Cejar, a place that offers us a unique experience in the middle of its saline waters. Here, we can immerse ourselves and enjoy a relaxing bath, floating effortlessly thanks to the high concentration of salt. It is an indescribable sensation that envelops us and allows us to disconnect from daily worries, while we let ourselves be carried away by the tranquility of this natural environment. Continuing our trip, we arrived at the Tebenquiche Lagoon, where we were amazed by the impressive formations and views that unfold before us. Here, the combination of the intense blue sky with the mountains and salt formations creates a dreamlike landscape. We will walk along its shores, delighting in the natural beauty that surrounds us, while we appreciate how the sunlight reflects in the crystalline waters of the lagoon. Return to your hotel in San Pedro.

Note: It is recommended to take sunglasses, sunscreen, and comfortable clothes, swimsuit (and underwear to change), towel, sandals, water and a coat for the sunset.

DAY 5 - SAN PEDRO DE ATACAMA - SEPTEMBER 30, 2025

Half day Mars Valley & Moon Valley

The Valley of the Moon, surrounded by sand dunes, evaporites, sinkholes and mountain ranges, offers a dazzling setting. Its characteristic brown color in contrast with the intense blue of the Atacama sky provides a visual treat for tourists. From the first moment, they are amazed by the uniqueness of this place. Until 1994, it was used as a site for the extraction of different types of salts, which allows us to travel in time and recreate the work of the Atacameñas or Lickanantai families. During the tour, visitors explore the Victoria Mine, immersing themselves in the history and legacy of the local communities. They experience firsthand the hard work of salt extraction and understand its cultural importance. There are stops at emblematic places such as Las Tres Marías, natural structures that seem to rise towards the sky. In addition, a memorable experience awaits at the end of the day: a visit to the Mars Valley to witness a spectacular sunset. This unique moment is lived with a special toast, celebrating the beauty of the landscape that, with its changing tones under the sunset sky, creates a magical atmosphere and a deep connection with nature. This act of celebration not only enriches the experience in the Atacama Desert, but also offers a moment of reflection and appreciation of the natural beauty that surrounds us, marking the perfect closing of an unforgettable day in this extraordinary environment

Note: It is recommended to bring sunglasses with UV filter, sunscreen, sun hat, comfortable clothing and trekking shoes.

DAY 6 - SANTIAGO/CUSCO/SACRED VALLEY - OCTOBER 1, 2025

DAY 7 - SACRED VALLEY- OCTOBER 2, 2025

Tour to Sacred Valley: Maras' Salt Plans, Archaeological Site of Moray, and Chinchero Ruins and Town.

This morning, we will continue the trip toward the Sacred Valley; at 17,40 miles (28km) away from Cusco, we will find Chinchero village, with an altitude 12,375 feet above sea level (3,772 meters), famous for the extraordinary beauty and quality of its textiles, and for its Sunday fair, where local people dress in traditional colorful outfits and travel down from their villages to trade their goods. We will head towards the Salt Pans of Maras. The sight of this still-operating salt mine, in use since Incan times, will amaze us the stark white of the steeply descending salt pans juxtaposed against the green of the surrounding mountain slopes. The journey will continue until we reach the archaeological site of Moray. Used as an agricultural testing ground, the site's system of circular terraces descends 490 feet (150m) from where we will stand, serving as a perfect testament to the level of advancement achieved by the Incas, who excelled at building masterful constructions in harmony with nature.

You will have picnic lunch in Huaypo lagoon.

DAY 8 -SACRED VALLEY/MACHU PICCHU/AGUAS CALIENTES - OCTOBER 3, 2025

Full day visit to the Historic Sanctuary of Machu Picchu departing from the Sacred Valley.

You will pick you up from your hotel at the scheduled time and go to train Station. The comfortable train ride from there to the station at Aguas Calientes is packed full of spectacular vistas

Vistadome Observatory Scenic Train 203 10:32-12:11

On your arrival, you will have lunch in Cafe Inkaterra restaurant.

Then, you will take a bus that will drop us at the admission fee to the citadel of Machu Picchu itself. Unearthed for modernity by Hiram Bingham more than a century ago, Machu Picchu is considered one of the seven wonders of the world. Its architectural beauty, spectacular natural setting, and the energy that radiates from its enigmatic buildings will take your breath away. We will follow in the footsteps of the ancient Incas as we take a tour of the magical citadel led by one of our guides.

Finally, you will return to Aguas Calientes.

DAY 10 - CUSCO - OCTOBER 5, 2025

Half Day Cusco city tour: Sacsayhuaman, Cristo Blanco, San Pedro Market, Qoricancha Inca Temple and Cusco Cathedral.

At scheduled time a guide with a private transfer will pick you up at the hotel. You will visit the Fortress of Sacsayhuaman, a colossal structure built with huge carved rocks joined with absolute accuracy. This astounding sample of the Incan military architecture is, undoubtedly, the greatest architectonic work of the Tahuantinsuyo. We will make a short stop at Cristo Blanco, a large statue where we will enjoy a panoramic view of the city. Then, we will explore the San Pedro Market, Cusco's main street market, inundated with aromas, tastes, sights, and colors of the local products of the Cusco region. Afterward, visit the Qoricancha (which means room of gold in Quechua), a temple dedicated to the Sun god. Legend has it that its inner walls were once completely lined with gold. Finally, will head to Cusco Cathedral. We will take a guided tour to discover the mysteries of it and admire its lovely atria and priceless 17th and 18th century paintings of the Cusco school.

DAY 11 - CUSCO/PUERTO MALDONADO - OCTOBER 6, 2025

At the appropriate time, you will transfer you from the hotel to Cusco airport to board the flight that will take you to Puerto Maldonado.

Following our arrival in Puerto Maldonado, you will be met at the airport and then begin the 30-kilometer river journey along the Madre de Dios River to the Eco Amazonia lodge.

Check-in | 3 overnight accommodations with breakfast, lunch, and dinner, plus group activities, at a jungle Amazon lodge.

After lunch, we will take a guided walk along a signposted interpretative trail to Caiman Lake, where it is possible to observe caimans, efficient hunters at the top of the jungle food chain which live on the many varieties of fish found in the lake. In the late afternoon, we will witness a spectacular Amazon sunset, an experience filled with overwhelmingly intense colors. Upon our return to the lodge, a delicious evening meal will be waiting for us. The nocturnal fauna will lull us to sleep, as the calls and songs of countless birds create a soothing melody.

DAY 12- PUERTO MALDONADO - OCTOBER 7, 2025

After breakfast, we will set off on a walk into the depths of the forest, following a network of trails as far as majestic Lake Apu Victor, surrounded by immense wetlands and gigantic trees. Along the way, we will be witnesses to an enormous variety of wild flora and fauna. At the lake, we will enjoy a spectacular panoramic view of its waters from the tall observation platform, from which it is also possible to spot parrots, macaws, toucans, horned screamers, hoatzins, herons, and other animals including caimans and turtles. After lunch, there will be time to visit Monkey Island, which is home to several species of primates, as well as other smaller species of mammals, and an enormous variety of colorful birdlife. Finally, we will pause to enjoy the spectacle of the sun setting over the forests of the Amazon basin. Back at the lodge, an exquisite farewell dinner will be waiting for us.

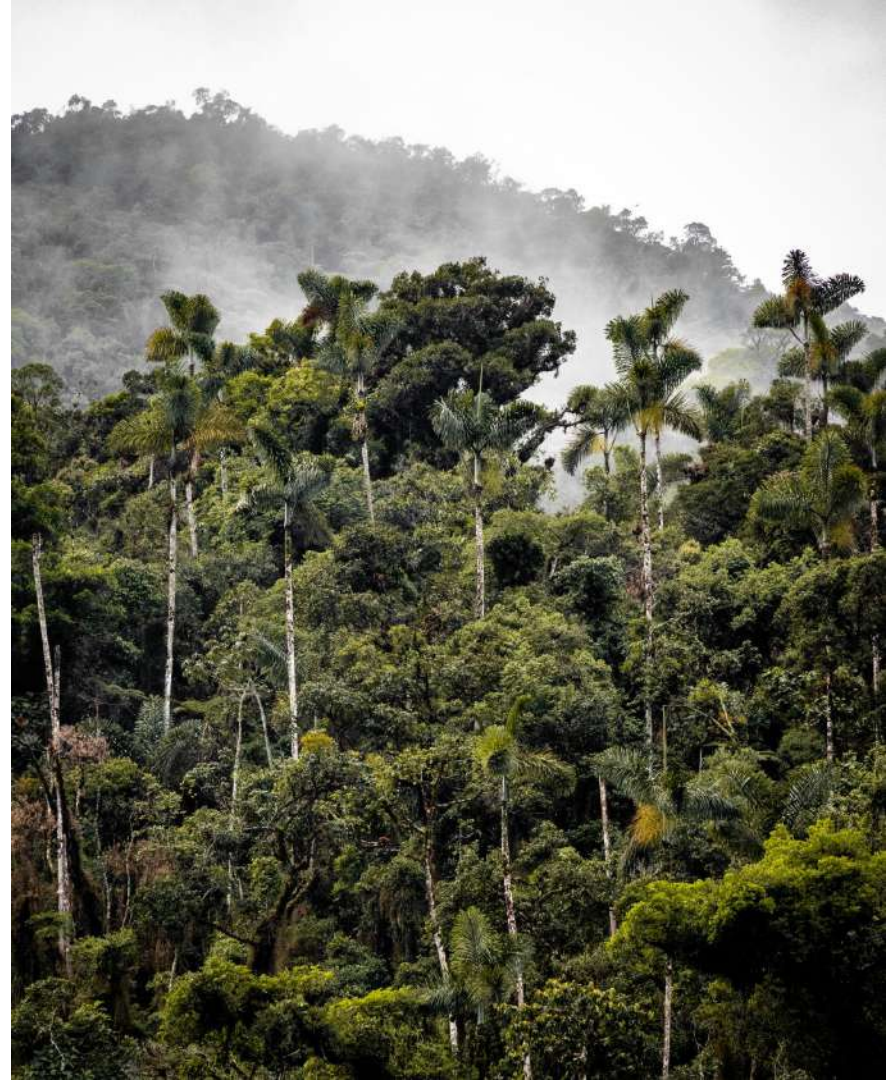




DAY 13 - PUERTO MALDONADO - OCTOBER 8, 2025

After breakfast, we will set off on a walk into the depths of the forest, following a network of trails as far as Cocha Perdida ("Lost Lake"). Along the way, we will be witnesses to an enormous variety of wild flora and fauna. When we arrive at Cocha Perdida, we will climb a tall observation platform, from where we can appreciate at close quarters the canopy of this magical forest. Descending from the observation tower, we will take a trip around the lake in search of giant otters, the largest known otter species and one of the Amazon basin's most impressive animals. After lunch, there will be time to visit Monkey Island, which is home to several species of primates, as well as other smaller species of mammals, and an enormous variety of colorful birdlife. Finally, we will pause to enjoy the spectacle of the sun setting over the forests of the Amazon basin. Back at the lodge, an exquisite farewell dinner will be waiting for us.

DAY 14 - PUERTO MALDONADO/ LIMA - OCTOBER 9, 2025

After a good night's rest, the powerful vocalizations produced by the howler monkey (*Alouatta seniculus*) will remind you that we are in the territory of this imposing primate, and that the time has come for us to leave.

You will eat breakfast before setting off on the return trip to Puerto Maldonado.

DAY 15 - LIMA - OCTOBER 10, 2025

Half Day Lima City tour: Cathedral, Santo Domingo Convent and Larco museum.

We will begin the visit of the city with an exploration of Colonial Lima. First, we will stop off at the Main Square, to explore it on foot and admire the exteriors of the Government Palace, the Cathedral, and the City Hall, all examples of Lima's still-present colonial architectural opulence. We will visit the Cathedral; as walking through its numerous chapels, we'll discover various architectural styles and learn about the religious history of Peru. We will continue with the visit to Santo Domingo Convent a religious and architectural gem that houses holy paintings, images, and relics of Peruvian saints, as well as written accounts of the endeavors of the Dominican Order across the country. Afterwards, we will head to Larco Museum, an eighteenth-century Viceregal mansion that houses more than 3,000 years of Peru's pre-Columbian history. The museum boasts a supremely fine collection of gold and silver jewelry and worship paraphernalia. The museum also contains a famous collection of erotic ceramic tomb art that gives insights into various aspects of pre-Columbian sexuality. Finally, we will begin a journey through the streets of modern Lima as head toward the most traditional of the residential zones of the capital: San Isidro, the heart of the city's financial district; and Miraflores, a perfect spot to enjoy wonderful views of the Pacific Ocean.
